- Mr. Hammond reported on Buildings and Grounds
- Snow removal was done at all buildings and walkways multiple times.
 - The work on the North Wing HVAC project at 56 Main Street continues.
 - The remodel of the Legislative Offices at 56 Main Street also continues.
 - Ceiling fans were replaced at the Highway garage.
 - The Dental van was moved from Tioga School to H.H.S.

- The first and second floor hallways were painted at H.H.S. utilizing (ATI).
- Mr. Hammond reported on the Highway Department.
 - Snow removal operations on County roadways continues.
 - Patch paving is ongoing on the roads.
 - The Highway Department cut down trees with Tri-County Tree Service on West River Drive.
 - Tree trimming is ongoing on County roads.
 - The Highway Department hauled sand to mix with salt.
 - All the trucks have been washed.
- Mr. Hammond reported on the Buildings and Grounds Capital Projects.
 - The Court Annex/Clerks and Courthouse roof project had been posted online with a bid opening on Wednesday, January 7th, 2026. DPW is waiting on concurrence from the engineering firm to award the contract.
 - The Ronald E. Dougherty Office Building North Wing HVAC upgrade project is continuing with isolated ductwork concerns that will result in a change order. With the changes, the schedule is still projected to have minimal delays.
 - The Public Safety Building New Utility Roll-up Door design is complete.
 - The Car Wash Facility is still in the design phase. The engineering firm has submitted a proposal that exceeds expectations regarding cost.
- Mr. Hammond reported on the Highway Capital Projects.
 - Day Hollow Road Culvert is back in design phase due to the additional scope of work; right of way paperwork is still being signed.
 - Glenmary Drive by Thorn Hollow Road is in final design phase.
 - Straits Corners Road over Pipe Creek is in preliminary design phase.
 - Brown Road Bridge over East Branch Owego Creek is in preliminary design phase.
 - Halsey Valley Road Culvert is in preliminary design phase.
- MISCELLANEOUS
 - Mr. Standinger mentioned that Probation is looking to acquire another vehicle so Mr. Hammond said he would contact them to discuss their needs.
 - A question was raised about bridge timelines and Mr. Hammond outlined a brief synopsis of the process and time expectations for bridge flagging, design and repair/construction for the edification of new Committee members and guests.
 - A concern was raised regarding speed limits in the county and Mr. Hammond reviewed the process of getting a speed limit changed.

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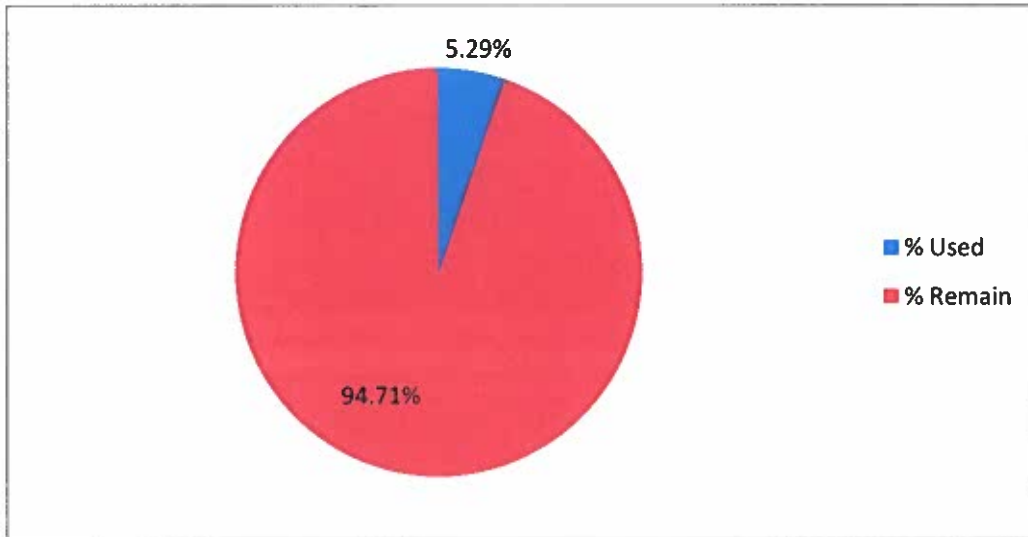

COPIER AT PUBLIC WORKS HIGHWAY GARAGE
(477 NY-RT 96)

WHEREAS: The Department of Public Works has determined there is a need for a new copier in the administrative office at 477 NY-RT 96 in Owego due to the existing copier nearing the end of service life; and

WHEREAS: ITCS can procure a Xerox™ C8245H2 model copier from Xerox™ directly at the New York State (NYS) contract purchase price of \$5,218.00; and

WHEREAS: Purchases through a valid NYS contract are exempt from the requirement to obtain three competitive quotes in accordance with applicable procurement regulations; and

WHEREAS: Amending of the budget, the appropriation of Capital funds, and utilization of Capital Reserve funds require Legislative approval; therefore be it
