TIOGA COUNTY COVID-19 UPDATE – AUGUST 6, 2020

Owego, NY – Tioga County Legislative Chairwoman Sauerbrey reported the following Tioga County COVID-19 Statistics:

- 199 Confirmed Cases Total confirmed cases, to date.
- 107 Individuals in Mandatory Quarantine These are individuals who have had close contact (6 ft.) with someone who has tested positive, but is not displaying symptoms for COVID-19; or individuals that have traveled to China, Iran, Japan, South Korea, or Italy and is displaying symptoms of COVID-19; or individuals who traveled outside of New York State to one of the states identified by the Governor with a mandatory 14-day quarantine period upon return.
- **160 Recovered** Total number of individuals who had a confirmed case of COVID-19 and are now symptom and fever-free that meet the criteria to be released from Isolation.
- 14 Active Cases
- 25 Deaths

This is a snapshot of data provided to Tioga County Public Health at this point in time. Administered tests are tracked in various ways. Test results are reported.

COVID-19 Public Notification:

Summer Meal Site at the Berkshire Library for August 4th from 10:00am - 12:00pm

Tioga County Public Health has received notice that an individual who worked at the Summer Meal Site at the Berkshire Library on Tuesday, August 4^{th} from 10:00am - 12:00pm has now tested positive for COVID-19. Anyone who was at the library between 10:00am - 12:00pm on August 4_{th} and/or was there to receive a summer meal, is asked to self-quarantine until Sunday, August 18^{th} to avoid further potential spread of the virus.

Anyone who was at the Berkshire Library on August 4th who becomes symptomatic (cough, fever, sore throat, headache, new loss of taste/smell etc.), should call their health care provider (do not just go there) and the Tioga County Public Health Department.
