

# Tioga County 2024 Early Voting Plan - FAQ

Updated May 1, 2024

**2024 Federal and State Primary Election – June 25, 2024**  
**2024 General Election – November 5, 2024**

The Board of Elections will release this plan to media outlets on May 2, 2024. A press release will also be issued with Early Voting information for each subsequent election eight (8) days before the start of Early Voting for that election. Early Voting notices will be distributed to municipal halls, party committees, and high schools for posting on public bulletin boards and websites. ## **What is Early Voting?**

Early Voting is a nine (9) day period where voters can vote in-person before each election administered by the Board of Elections.

## **Who can vote early?**

All registered voters can vote early.  
Remember that for primary elections in NY, you must be enrolled in a political party holding a primary to be eligible to vote in that primary.

## **When can I vote early?**

Early Voting in New York State will occur prior to the June 25th Federal and State Primary Election. The Early Voting period will be from: **Saturday, June 15, 2024 through Sunday, June 23, 2024.** In Tioga County, all primaries are uncontested and polls will be closed, pending litigation. If litigation results in a contested primary, polls will be open for Early Voting during the following times:

Early Voting in New York State will occur prior to the November 5th General Election. The Early Voting period will be from: **Saturday, October 26, 2024 through Sunday, November 3, 2024**. In Tioga County, polls will be open for Early Voting during the following times:

### Where can I vote early?

You can vote in the Tioga County Early Voting Center, located by the Board of Elections in the Health and Human Services Building, **1062 State Route 38, Owego, NY 13827**.

### How will I vote during Early Voting?

Voting during Early Voting is the same as voting on Election Day. When you get to the Early Voting center, you will check in to vote, receive your ballot and vote as in any other election.

There will be instructions available at the Early Voting Center to familiarize you with the ballot. There will also be a Notice to Voter and Bill of Rights. You may ask an election inspector to explain how to vote, or if you need any assistance.

If you vote during the Early Voting period, you are not eligible to vote on Election Day.

### When will Early Voting results be posted?

Early Voting results will be canvassed and reported after 9 pm on Tuesday, June 25, 2024 for the Federal and State Primary Election and after 9 pm on Tuesday, November 5, 2024 for the General Election.
